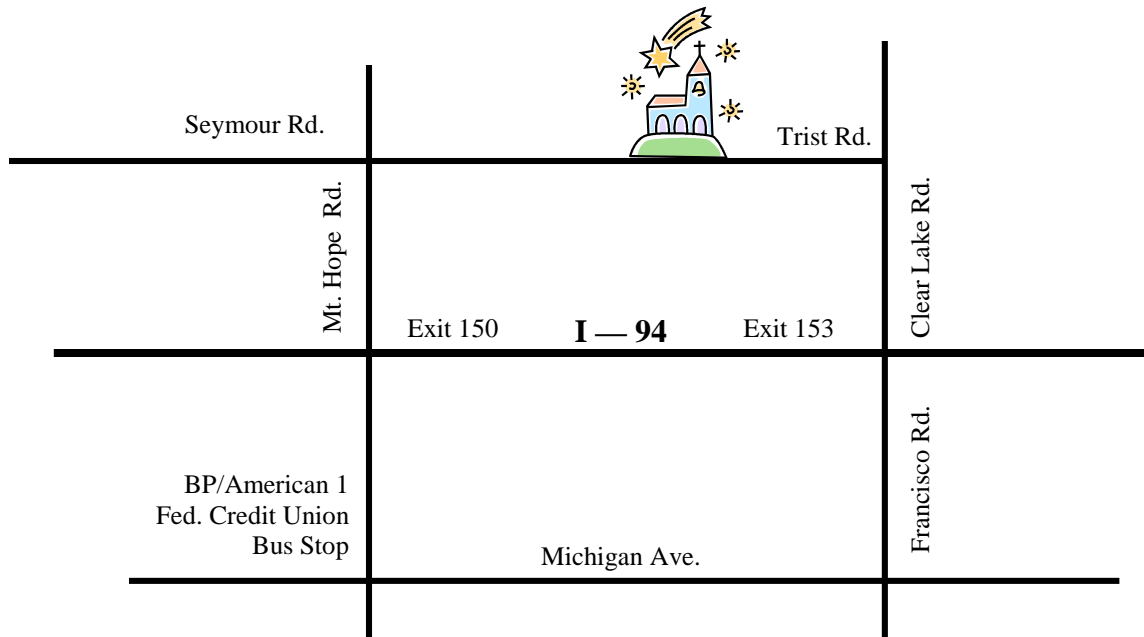

Day Camp is held July 20-24, from 9:30
a.m. to 3:00 p.m. (rain or shine). On Friday,
July 24, Day Camp will start at 1:00 p.m.
and conclude at 6:00 p.m. with Family
Night. For about \$1 an hour your child will
enjoy a fun Christian camp experience!

Attendance: Campers do not have to
attend every day to be able to come, but
they'll benefit most if they come every day.

Transportation: We'll pick up campers at
9:15 a.m. at BP/American 1 Federal Credit
Union in Grass Lake and bring them back
there at 3:15 p.m.

Lunch: Each camper is expected to bring
their own sack lunch (put your name on it
please!). We will furnish the drink (and
plenty of water during the day).

Insurance: Each camper is covered by a
limited insurance policy at camp.

Visitors: Campers are encouraged to bring
visitors. The daily fee is \$6. The visitor
must be between the ages of 7-13.

Family Night: Our Day Camp ends with a
Family Night. This gives the families of our
campers the opportunity to see the program
in action and the campers receive their
awards. It begins at 6:00 p.m. on Friday
July 24.

Teen Helpers: Those 14 years old or older
are invited to be "helpers" at Day Camp.
This is a great experience for the teens.
Please contact us if you want to help. There
is a mandatory meeting for helpers on July
19 at 4:30 p.m. to prepare them for their
responsibilities.

Each camper can choose two activities.
If archery or jewelry making is chosen
the camper must be at least 9 years old.

*Air Riflery

Learn safety and proper technique.
You'll see how skilled you can become.

*Archery (9+)

Learn 5 levels of archery safety and
skills on nice compound bows.

*Cooking

Healthful eating, kitchen math, food
safety, setting the table and cleaning up.

*Fun in the Sun

Wacky, zany, outdoor activities that are
sure to be fun in the sun.

*Hands On Fun

Learn how to make simple gifts (or keep
them) . Create with your own hands.

*Jewelry Making (9+)

Have fun making jewelry you can wear
or give as gifts.

*Outdoor Life

Experience special "tricks of the trade"
to make life in the woods easier and a
lot more fun.

*Each camper will have an opportunity
to participate in two activities, Bible
study, swimming and game time.
Please bring modest swim suits and
towels (two piece swimsuits for girls
are not allowed unless a t-shirt is worn
over them). Campers are bussed to
